4	Achievements of the Working Group in last year (250 words)	The Eumycetoma Working Group has organised a working group session in the 18th Congress of the International Society for Human and Animal Mycology in June 2012 in Berlin, Germany. During this meeting an initiative was made to attract more attention of the World Health Organisation for mycetoma, and put mycetoma on the neglected tropical diseases list of the WHO. Therefore on 1st February 2013, we held a meeting with the Drugs for neglected diseases initiative (DNDi) in Geneva to plan a strategy to get this attention. In this meeting, members from South-America, Africa and Europe were present. In this meeting it was decided to meet in Nairobi to discuss the matter further in June 2013. In order to raise awareness for mycetoma, we requested PLoS Neglected Tropical Diseases to host a special issue on mycetoma with

		reviews on several topics on this disease, including a look into future efforts. Furthermore we requested to host a special symposium on mycetoma in the 62 nd annual meeting of the American society of tropical medicine and hygiene in Washington DC, to gain attention for mycetoma. Next to obtaining attention for mycetoma, the meetings are also used to determine the research priorities on mycetoma and divide the tasks to the different members of the working group, in the end to help the research on mycetoma further.
