



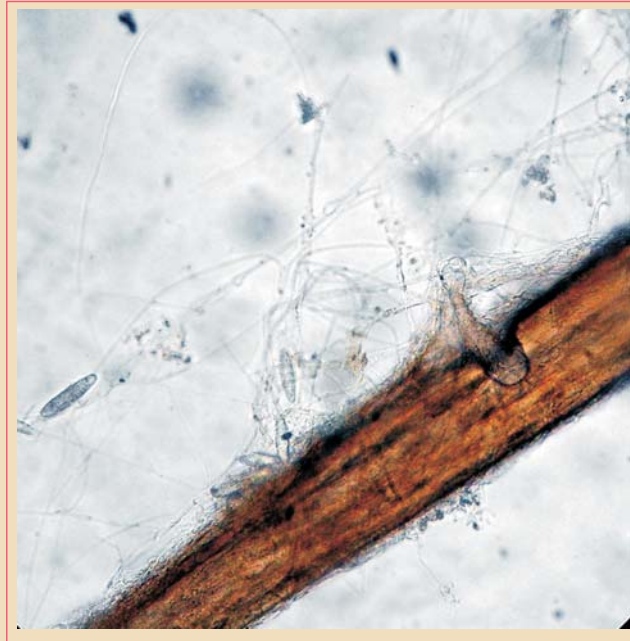

Practical Class on “Dermatophytes: from the clinic to the laboratory.”

This one-day intensive Class is going to take place in Athens on July 17 2010, and it is addressed to local clinical microbiologists. The official language of the course will be Greek. It is organized at a local level to stimulate interest for the ISHAM Working Group “PCR-based diagnosis of Dermatophytic infections: on the way to a consensus” and is awarded 6 CME credits.

Description of the event:

Theoretical sessions include:

History of dermatophyte research, taxonomy, nomenclature, geographic distribution, ecology, diseases caused by dermatophytes, prevention and treatment.

Practical sessions include:

The technique of specimen collection from nails-skin-hairs

The technique of specimen preparation for direct microscopy

The technique of specimen collection from nails-skin-hairs

Specimen transportation

Identification algorithm of dermatophytes in routine laboratory practise.

PCR-based methods of diagnosis of dermatophytes.

Interpretation of Results – From the clinical picture to diagnosis and therapy.

Interactive presentation and discussion on cases with dermatophytoses (Quiz).
